Children must be registered for the program using the SMOSHC enrolment form available from the College office or the SMOSHC Director.

After School Care - Vacation Care

Families who use our OSHC (Out of School Hours Care) service are eligible to receive a Child Care Benefit (CCB) rebate from the Family Assistance Office (FAO). Due to SMOSHC being a totally self-funded service, it is important that all accounts are paid in full 14 days after date of invoice. Families who use the service will receive an invoice every month.

After school care generally involves a snack, free time, programmed activities and an opportunity for students to do homework.
