



Middle & Senior School Scholarships for 2024

Eligibility: Scholarships are open to both new and existing students, currently studying in Year 6 (for Middle School) and Year 9 (for Senior School) in the year of the application.

Value: The scholarship will provide full or part reduction of tuition fees for 3 years per Scholarship.

Middle School:

- A three-year Scholarship for students entering Year 7 in 2024

Senior School:

- A three-year scholarship for students entering Year 10 in 2024

Please note: If you have already been awarded a St Martins Scholarship you are not eligible to apply for any further scholarships within the College, until the completion of that Scholarship contract.

The scholarship does not cover the costs of uniform, stationery, instrumental music tuition, excursions, camps, bus travel and other incidentals – these remain the responsibility of the student's family / guardian.

The number of scholarships offered for any year will be determined by the Principal in consultation with the College Council.

Criteria: Scholarships will be awarded on academic merit based on a scholarship test, student reports and a teacher reference.

Participation in school and community activities will also be taken into consideration.

Attendance at a pre-enrolment interview with College staff will be requested for new students.

Scholarships will be reviewed annually, and will then continue providing students:

1. Apply themselves diligently across all of their academic studies and achieve at a level commensurate with their abilities.
2. Adhere to all school discipline and behaviour policies and maintain good standing in the school community.
3. Participate positively in the wider life of the school, involving themselves in areas such as school worship / devotions, music, drama, sport, student leadership, community service, debating, public speaking and other extra-curricular activities.

Applying: Applicants are required to complete the scholarship application form and forward it to the College office.

All applications must be accompanied by a \$25.00 application fee. For students new to the College, a copy of the applicant's most recent school report and a teacher / school reference are required.

New students to St Martins will also be required to submit an enrolment application form with their Scholarship Application.

Students will sit two hours of scholarship tests (with breaks) in numeracy and literacy. The tests are scheduled to be held at **9am on Saturday 29th July or Monday 31st July 3:30pm 2023**, whichever suits you best.

Results: Scholarship results will be advised approximately four to six weeks after the scholarship test date.

All applications must be received by 4:00 pm on **Friday 30th June 2023**.
