

Sports Scholarships

Fact Sheet – 2026 Entry

St Martins Lutheran College offers a limited number of scholarships at Year 7 and Year 10, available to both current and prospective students. These scholarships are awarded to individuals who demonstrate a high level of excellence in their chosen area, along with a strong personal commitment.

The scholarships are available in various categories, including:

- Academic Scholarships
- Performing Arts Scholarships (Drama, Music)
- Creative Arts Scholarships (Media Arts, Visual Art)
- Sport Scholarships

Scholarships are awarded for a period of three years, either from Year 7 to 9 or from Year 10 to 12. Students who receive a Scholarship commencing in Year 7 will be required to reapply should they wish to be considered for a scholarship in Year 10. Please note that the College reserves the right to withdraw a scholarship in the event of significant breaches of expectations, a decline in academic performance, or insufficient participation in co-curricular activities.

All scholarships cover only the tuition fee component of the student's school fees. Costs related to uniforms, stationery, instrumental music tuition, excursions, camps, bus travel, and other incidentals remain the responsibility of the student's family or guardian. The remission amount, which ranges from 30% to 50% of the school fees, is determined by the Principal. The number of scholarships offered each year is also decided by the Principal.

Criteria

- Active involvement and success in any sport or sports.
- Students must be performing at a high level and participate regularly in school or club representative sport.
- Applicants should be capable of achieving at a regional or state level.
- Information about specific achievements in competition/representation should be submitted via the cover sheet and portfolio. This information must include details of representation in school and/or club sport programs and be evidenced in the portfolio.
- Student selection is based on a portfolio submission and, if shortlisted, an interview. Shortlisted applicants who are invited for an interview will be notified of the date and time via email.

A Successful Sports Scholarship Student will be expected to meet the following conditions:

- Maintain a high effort level (EPA)
- Remain in good standing with the College in relation to:
 - Behaviour
 - Attendance
 - Compliance with other College expectations
- Participate in nominated school-based sporting activities, such as training sessions, competitions and other activities and events as notified.
- Agree, within parameters determined by the Principal/ and/or Coordinator of Sport, to participate in College activities.
- Show support to the leadership role that is implicit for all scholarship holders. This includes being a positive role model for younger students, displaying leadership by encouraging and supporting other students and fostering team and College spirit.

The College reserves the right to terminate the scholarship in the event of gross or continued breaches of behaviour expectations, unwarranted decline in academic achievement or application, or persistent failure to support the College in its co-curricular program.

Application Checklist:

Applicants are to submit a Portfolio including:

- □ A portfolio of sporting abilities and achievements
- □ Two references that support your application
- A completed Application form along with the \$25 application fee
 Non-current Students must also provide:
- □ A completed College Enrolment Application (the \$50 application fee will only be required if you are a successful scholarship recipient)
- □ A recent School Report and, if applicable, national test results (e.g., NAPLAN)

* Please note: Applicants may apply for multiple scholarships but only one may be awarded. A nonrefundable, one-time \$25 application fee applies, regardless of the number of applications submitted.
